The Eagle Township Trustees met in regular session on 4/30/2020. The meeting was opened by Jeff Elkins. Elkins, Vanover Jr. and Anders were in attendance.

The Pledge of Alligence was said

The minutes were read and approved.

Fiscal Officer approached the board with concerns of new employee Vincent Hutchinson only having 10 hours for the month of April. At this point Mr. Elkins moves they go into executive session ORC 121.22G1 to discuss employees.

Trustees came back out of executive session. Mr. Elkins then reported that Mr. Vincent Hutchinson will not be a township employee any longer due to performance issues, to pay him for the 10 hours he worked at \$15.00 an hour.

Fiscal Officer gave the board a letter from Chillicothe Fire and Security to contact them concerning having all the fire extinguishers maintained .

Went over culvert invoices with the board had one that was in question from last month. Mr. Elkins verified which job they were for.

OLD NEWS

Elkins asked board if they were in agreement to have the Web site turned on May 11th 2020. Fiscal Officer advised trustees one thing that would be nice to have on the Website would be pictures of all the cemeteries in the township. Elkins would like an announcement put on WKKJ letting the public know it will be available for viewing. Elkins asked trustees about putting minutes of the meeting on the Web site. Anders said lets get it up and going and see how things go before adding minutes. There will be a place for comments from the public. Mr. Elkins is going to do a training with Paint Street Productions so he can add to web site as needed.

Laura Adock gave a 3 month extension on the force account FEMA jobs.

Mr. Elkins talked with Greg Wells on Dixon Mill road. Everything was turned into Washington . Not sure whats going to happen with the project at this time. Washington isn't sure 600,000.00 is worth spending on Dixon Mill per the data that was given. What kind of hardship would it be not putting the wall up you would be have emergency services, mail carriers, and school busses that would have to go all the way around. Wells will revise and send back to Washington . Elkins said he would rather USDA take care of all bids and engineering on the job. Trustees agree.

NEW NEWS

Stevens branch - Elkins talked with owner about fence sitting close to road

will need to cut fence to repair ditch/culvert. The owners said they would be willing to take down for trustees. Elkins asked the board what they thought about asking if they would take the whole fence down with it being on the right of way and it is hard for trustees to mow and plow the road. All trustees agree it would be easier if the fence was gone.

Riddle Road : Top of hill Dwight Ross moved in talking about putting in a driveway.

Mr. Elkins gave them a driveway/culvert permit to fill out. Told them they cannot fill in our ditch the permit has to be followed. Had a few signs stolen off of the road maybe riders thinking its the Jenkins trying to keep people out.

Mr. Elkins said should be getting a invoice from Wagner Rental for the trac hoe rental. Also added that there will be an extra \$1400.00 on invoice due to a accident that happened while being used . Township needs to pay for the parts to repair.

Jim was asking who was responsible for maintaining on past Riddle Road. He was asking if DNR would be willing to maintain with it being a National Trail. Mr. Elkins says no that is not how it works. Mr. Elkins said they need to take a saw and cut trees out of the road and stay off private land. Mr. Anders had people asking. Elkins told Anders anyone can maintain a unmaintained road but they can't keep people from using it.

Elkins gave driveway/culvert permit to resident on Dixon mill.

Fiscal Officer approached the Board on the upcoming Audit. Told trustees the State Auditors office (Allice) checked our Dec. 2018 and December 2019 cash books and we qualify for the Audit by the State at a cheaper cost. Mr. Vanover made a motion to have done by the state 2nd by Anders . All votes yes. Still waiting to here from UAN on the new system for training.

Fiscal Officer is working on a chart for road maintance. Fiscal officer had given Elkins forms he wanted made up before meeting for maintence records.
