



The Eagle Township Trustees met in regular session on August 29 2019. All Board members were in attendance. Also in attendance was Mr. Archer from the Prosicutor office along with Mr. Gary Miller. The meeting was opened by Mr. Elkins.

Mr. Miller was here on behalf of the Amish community to discuss a Amish cemetery. Mr. Miller believes the land is 1/2 acre has been tiled off for cemetery. Mr. Archers concern is a right of way to the said cemetery if the Amish would move out of the community and the township would then be liable for the up keep. Mr. Archer would like a legal document to be in place in case this would arise. Mr. Archer advised Mr. Miller to set up a deed so if they would leave the area the cemetery can be handed over to the Eagle Township Trustees . Mr. Miller advised the board he would have a meeting in church to dicuss the issue.

There is a culvert issue on Dixon Mill by Lanie Carter at the Ross line. Mr. Carter and Mr. Wilburn were invited to the meeting to discuss the issue. Neither one attended. Mr. Wilburn had a conversation with Mr. Elkins, he was going to move the culvert on his own. Elkins advised him not to touch it at this time. It would need to be repaired in the same way the township would.

Mr. Channell asked Mr. Archer about being appointed for his next term in office. He didn't make the dead line for getting put on the ballot for the November election. He advised him there is a small amount of time that the trustees have to appoint a trustee to the vacant spot. We are to contact him on said issue closer to time.

Fiscal Officer gave Mr. Elkins the paper work from fema on extension directions/information for the projects.

Mr. Elkins makes a motion to have culvert repairs on Haines Hollow x2 estimate is \$9,800.00. Will recheck on cost if usig our own culverts we have in stock. Mr. Channel 2nd, all votes yes.

Trustees agree to skip on chip and seal this year until the culverts, fema work and the ditches are taken care of.

Mr. Elkins makes a motion to adopt a resolution to have driveway permit process along with a culvert permit. Such questions as location , where, how its going to be done and why its necessary.
2nd by Jack Vanover Jr. All votes Yes.
