

The Eagle Township Trustees met in regular session on Feb 28th 2019 at the Township house. The meeting was opened by Mr. Jeff Elkins all board members were present along with guest Robert (Bob) Tatman in attendance. The minutes were read and approved.

Trustees discussed with day light savings time approaching the monthly meetings will begin at 8:30pm on the last Thursday of the month beginning at the March 28th 2019 meeting.

Mr. Tatman approached the board advising them he hasn't heard any response since the January meeting concerning Lady Run.

The Trustees advised him the man would need to be insured and bonded in order to work for the township. The Trustees advised him they would rather rent a dozer and do the work themselves.

Mr. Tatman then offered the Trustees \$350.00 to help with the bill of the dozer rental in order for them to repair the said road.

Mr. Elkins makes a Resolution to move Lady Run E-3 in Eagle Township to maintained from unmaintained starting from Jackson Twsp. line off Macedonia Rd. traveling .581 miles Northeast on Lady Run to a point past Mr. Tatman's drive way.
