

The Eagle Township Trustees met in regular session on July 30 2020. The meeting was opened by Jeff Elkins with the Pledge of Alligence. All Board members were in attendance.

Minutes were read and approved.

Fiscal Officer asked for a receipt for Washington Auto Mr. Elkins turned in.

Fire levy Resolution : Jack Vanover Jr. made a motion to adopt said resolution to Proceed. 2nd by James Anders. All votes were yes.

Fiscal Officer had a question concerning the gravel bills from Melvin Stone for the contract road work. S&C construction sent gravel haul receipts to fiscal officer day of meeting need to match them up to invoices. Mr. Elkins said to wait on paying the bill until we make sure all the receipts match up.

Mr. Elkins had Fiscal print off a invoice from S&C day of meeting. After reviewing the invoice Fiscal Officer found a mistake in the total for the culvert replacements. Mr. Elkins talked to contractor about invoice said he would take off at the end of job. Fiscal Officer would like another invoice printed for this instead of subtracting from the Chip and Seal invoice. to keep things the same on the estimates.

Vanover Jr. asked who dropped all the cold patch on Dixon Mill on side of the road, around 6-7 ton wasted that could have went in other pot holes. Elkins said he did see and needed to talk with S&C this week to discuss this issue.

Had a complaint about dumping on private land. Elkins asked trustees if there was anything that could be done by us . He talked to Pros. she does prosecute for dumping if it is caught. Complaint was from Duane Wagner T@D productions. Jack said they needed to contact Sheriff if its on private property. Elkins said he's not opposed to helping catch them with cameras ect. He is going to follow up with residents in township.

Dixon Mill : USDA letter was mailed along with a easement from The Browns.

Ditch was dug out and taken care on Dixon Mill.

McGee @ Caskeys, County is taking care of culvert and putting a good base from road. Trustees will have to gravel a short distance.

Letter was sent to Commissioners office about Ratcliff Hill. Trustees say our side is the better half. Letter was from Richard at end of Gearing he's not the only one complaining about road.

Commissioners office contacted Mr. Elkins concerning a load limit reduction sign on Wilt Road (to preserve road for repair) had put up in May. Told he needed to go

through the correct channels before doing so. The commissioners office had complaints asking when and why sign was put up. Mr. Elkins removed the sign.

Dixon Mill culvert issue : Mr. Elkins feels there is two options . Mr. Seymour and Lyndsey give a permanent easement and cut 5 feet off and maintain. or No easement cut at our line and maintain from there or a third option take culvert out and leave a ditch that would need to stay open. Seymour is not wanting to sign an easement. Fiscal Officer recommended to send a letter with options to land owners let them decide. Will decide at next meeting.

Jack proposes any and all work should have an easement to go on anyone's land to do and type of work in the township. Jeff going to talk with Pros. and commissioners to see what their policy is.

Board to think about and talk about it at the next meeting.
