

July 30<sup>th</sup>

The Eagle Township Trustees met in regular session on July 30, 2020. The meeting was opened by Jeff Elkins with the Pledge of Alleigence. Board members Jeff Ekins, James Anders and Jack Vanover Jr. were in attendance.

The minutes were read and approved.

Fiscal Officer advised Board the Fire levy was up to be on ballot for the November 3 election 2020 after a discussion Mr. Elkins moved to adopt the 2.0 mill Fire levy resolution . 2nd by Jack Vanover Jr. votes as follows Elkins - yes Vanover - yes and Anders - yes.

Mr. Elkins gave \$300.00 cash to fiscal officer for payment of cemetery plots 28/29 in the Lebanon cemetery for Samantha Kliewer/Corey Lee Cosgray.

Driveway permit update : Assistant Procecuter Layna Rodgers said go ahead with process. Roy is gonna send letter letting the township be in control of culvert permits.

Seymour culvert on land. Should we cut off of their water line and get an easement to clean when needed. 2nd get a easement Cut off at road way and put a bassin in to clean out. Vanover asked how hes gonna clean it . Says will plug up after rains everytime. Would have to have a truck come out and pump it out each time it fills up. Vanover recommends cut 5 feet off so not on water line and gets a permanant easement. Mr. Elkins asked what if they want payment for easement. What about compensation if we mess up line ? Pros. opinion is to pull it now. Will need to have an easment from both Seymour and Lynsey. Jim says cut 5 feet off and get easement. Elkins had call from Roy on 6-23, Dave Seymour and Marshall Wilburn were in his office talking about the said culvert. Will discuss more next meeting.

Elkins is getting copies of cemetery map for Anders and Vanover Jr.

Two culverts are in on Dixon Mill then prep then chip and seal. Then will be doing Gearing and Stevensbranch. Found 10 more culverts that needs replaced on Stevensbranch, Dixon and Gearing as long as NOT over \$5,000.00 additional cost . They will be using our inventory . Elkins makes motion to have done 2nd by Vanover Jr. All votes yes.

Trevor Tomerin - Dixon Mill last house on left. Temporary easment Ditch comes out of yard. Pot hole in front of his place. To clean ditch out on his property coming into townships ditch along the road.

Dixon Mill project : Greg Wells gave assurance papers. Fiscal Officer is going to call Wells and ask him about the form.
