

The Eagle Township Trustees met in a special session on June 15th 2020. The meeting was opened by Mr. Jeff Elkins. The Pledge of Alliegnece was said.

ELkins, Vanover Jr and Anders in attendance.

Recieved bids from Allied construction and S&C construction.

Elkins approached the board with an issue on Dixon Mill a sewer at the Lyndsey/Seymour residence is setting over the water lines and needs to be moved. Mr. Elkins is getting a temporary easement from the owner to have work completed. Vanover says its not that old to leave it. Mr. Elkins is going to check the deed at courthouse to see if there is a perminant easement to clean and maintain. Anders going to go look and see what he thinks. To be discussed at the next Board meeting. Fiscal officer is typing up easement for Elkins to have signed by owners.

After going over the bids for the Prep and Chip and Seal the trustees decided to wait on Riddle Rd due to gravel cost on the other roads may run over the appropriated amount. Dixon Mill is first on the list , then Gearing Ridge and Stevensbranch . Elkins advised trustees someone has placed a sign on Gearingridge "Trustees please fix potholes".

Elkins made a phone call to S&C to get an estimate on what he thinks the gravel will cost for the prep work. He thought around \$15,000.00 . He also explained a few things to trustees during a conference call during meeting.

For the 3 roads in questioned Allied Construction came in at 122,117.30 and S&C construction came in at 90,582.00 plus 15,000.00 for gravel expence. (bids on file)

Mr. Vanover Jr. Made a motion to go with S&C Construction for the road work on Dixon Mill, Gearing Ridge and Stevensbranch. 2nd by Anders . Votes Vanover -yes Anders- yes Elkins - yes . If any money is left over from the 15,000.00 gravel allowence trustees may consider doing chip and seal of Riddle Road.
